

All the candidates aspiring to seek admission in B.Voc. (Interior Design) at Academy of Architecture are hereby informed that the Entrance / Aptitude Test shall be conducted on Saturday, 23rd June 2018 between 10.00a.m. to 1.00p.m.

About Entrance/Aptitude Test

This Test measures the aptitude of the applicant for specific field of study, i.e. Interior Design. The test measures drawing and observation skills, sense of proportion, aesthetic sensitivity and critical thinking ability that have been acquired over a long period of time, and that are related to specific field of study.

The Aptitude Test will assess the general aptitude of the applicant, and the institute does not encourage applicants to join any formal training for the same.

Entrance/Aptitude Test : **Paper Format**

Section 1 – Aesthetic Sensitivity / General Aptitude 100 Marks

Aesthetic Sensitivity test will contain Multiple-Choice Questions and questions based on Observation Skills. No negative marking. These will be based upon: Logical Reasoning, Visual Analysis and General Aptitude.

Section 2 - Drawing Test 100 Marks

This is a Paper based test, which judges the drawing aptitude of the candidate, on the following aspects:

- Ability to sketch a given object proportionately and rendering the same in visually appealing manner
- Visualizing and drawing the effects of light on the object and shadows cast on surroundings
- Sense of perspective drawing
- Combining and composing given three dimensional elements to form a building or structural form
- Creating interesting two dimensional composition using given shapes and forms
- Creating visual harmony using colors in given composition
- Understanding of scale and proportions
- Drawing from memory through pencil sketch on themes from day to day experiences.

The Answer to each question in the paper will be examined and moderated independently and the marks shall be averaged. The primary emphasis in scoring the aptitude test is on the candidate's drawing, imagination and observation skills. The candidate's sense of proportion and perspective are also evaluated together with sense for color and composition. The aim of the drawing test is to assess the candidate's imagination, drawing and observation skills.

Things to carry

- Bring the receipt given by the office on submission of form. Treat it as your ADMIT CARD for the examination.
- Proof of Identity- Aadhar/ Passport/ Driving License (original and photo copy of any one)
- Pen, pencils, eraser, pencil colours (Not water/oil colour or crayon). Instruments of any kind including scale are not permitted.
- Candidates may bring with them a cardboard or a clip board on which nothing should be written, so that they have no difficulty in attempting the drawing test even if the tables provided in the examination room/hall do have smooth surface.

General Instructions

- Candidates must have the receipt [ADMIT CARD] given by the office on submission of form for admission to the Examination Hall.
- Candidate not possessing of the ADMIT CARD and valid photo identity (in original) shall not be allowed to enter in the Examination Hall by the Center-in-Charge.
- Candidates found carrying any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except those listed, inside Examination Hall, will be debarred from the examination.
- Mobile Phones, Bluetooth devices, Calculators, Slide Rules, Log Tables, Electronic Watches with facilities of Calculator are not allowed in the Examination Hall. Possession of such items during the Examinations may lead to cancellation of candidature.
- No candidate, without the special permission of the Centre-in-Charge, will leave his/her seat or Examination Hall until the duration of examination is over.
- Candidates shall maintain silence during the examination. Any conversation or gesticulation or disturbance in the examination hall shall be deemed as misdemeanor. If a candidate is found adopting unfair means, his/her candidature shall be cancelled and he/she will be liable to be debarred from taking examination either permanently or for a period according to the nature of offence.
- No further examination shall be held under any circumstances for those who will be unable to appear on the scheduled date and time of the Entrance/Aptitude Test.

Please Note: Attempting and Passing the Entrance/Aptitude Test does not entitle the candidate to securing admission to B. Voc. [Interior Design] Program. Abiding to the Eligibility criteria for the course prescribed by the University of Mumbai, admission shall be only given to those candidates who pass the HSC Examination. Necessary documents shall have to be produced at the time of admission. Though, 12th Standard (H.S.C) from any stream (Arts / Commerce / Science) or equivalent education, is the prescribed eligibility criteria; admissions shall be purely done on the Merit List of the Entrance/Aptitude Test.
